Schlenke, McCarroll Earn LEED APs At A.Z. Shmina

A.Z. Shmina Inc., Brighton, has announced that two of its team members have recently earned LEED (Leadership in Energy & Environmental Design) status – Michael Schlenke and John McCarroll.

A project director, Schlenke has been with Shmina team for the past two years where he has managed its Toledo, Ohio, operation, building schools and university structures. He has been responsible for over \$1 billion dollars worth of projects in his career.

Schlenke has also has OSHA/MIOSHA asbestos training, is a member of the American Society of Civil Engineers and the Engineering Society of Detroit, is a licensed builder, and has been an arbitrator with the American Arbitration Association since 1994. He has a bachelor of science in construction engineering from Lawrence Technological University.



McCarroll, a project manager, has also been with the company for two years, joining the firm from Whiting-Turner Contracting of Baltimore, Maryland. There he was involved in hospital projects and work for various government agencies. He recently completed the \$7 million renovation project at the University of Michigan Hospital Cardiovascular Center and is in the process of beginning yet another project there.

He has completed OSHA 30 hour training, is First Aid/CPR Certified, is a Certified Professional Constructor, and a licensed builder. He is a graduate of Ferris State University with a bachelor of science in

construction management.

A.Z. Shmina Inc. has already completed two Gold LEED projects. The first is the Memorial Fieldhouse at the University of Toledo, which involved a total reconstruction of the 200,000 square foot interior of the historic landmark. The second project, Hawkins Elementary School, is also in Toledo and is the third school the company has completed for Toledo Public Schools.
